

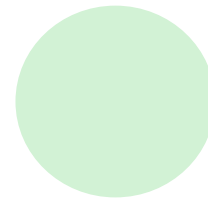
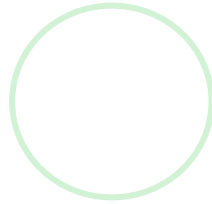

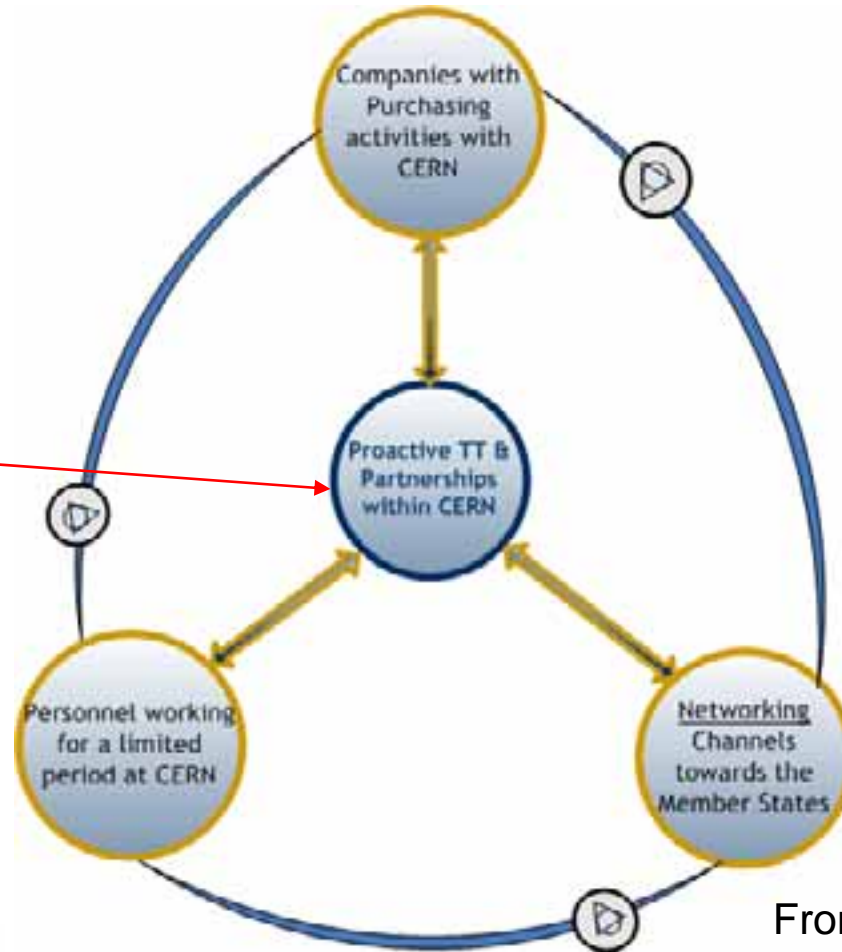

Quicker TT call also for...



- Big Science already involve industry early in development of frontier-pushing standards;
- **Reinforced partnership** (*by leveraging exchanges and knowledge transfer between in-house experts, identifying and accompanying projects having the highest technological learning potential*). This bring new TT perspectives for procurements of prototypes
 - **NEXT STEP** due also to lifetime of projects should also include for cutting-edge technological developments
- To carry out in parallel development application for sectors outside HEP. (explore financing modalities i.e. public funds)

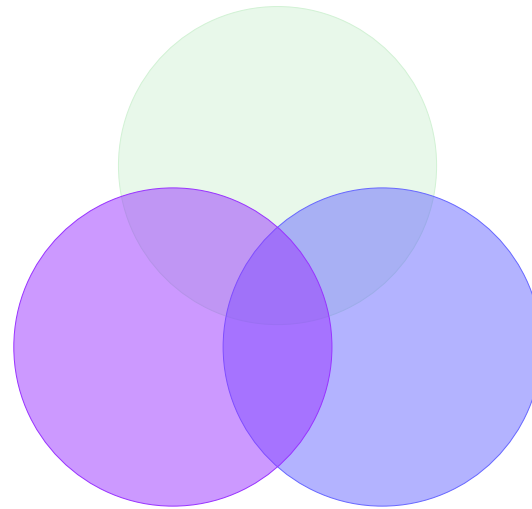
